## **Notice of Race**

All competitors are informed about the prescription about the COVID spread limitations and contrasts, included in the Italian Federation's protocol. Failure to follow these guidelines, they will be notified by the Organizing Authority to the Government Authorities.

Rules for which penalties are upon the Protests Committee. Depending on the seriousness of the breach of point 3.5, the penalty may be from a minimum of 10% to a disqualification.

## 1. DATE, AND ORGANISING AUTHORITY

- 1.1. The Eurocup will be held at Campione del Garda from the 7<sup>th</sup> to the 9<sup>th</sup> of May 2021.
- 1.2. The organizing authority is the FIV which delegates its organization to the affiliate Univela Sailing s.s.d.a r.l. in collaboration with ASWC Lake Garda and in conjunction with the Classe Italiana Flying Dutchman.

## 2. VENUE

#### 3. RULES:

- 3.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 3.2 The sailing instructions may consist contain minor changes to the RRS.
- 3.3 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.









## 4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all Flying Dutchman certified boats.
- 4.2 Competitors must be registered at their National Class for the year 2021.
- 4.3 Competitors shall present upon registration:
  - a) Italian sailors shall show their FIV membership card 2021 with valid medical certificate.
  - b) Foreigner sailors shall carry the membership card issued by their national authority.
  - c) If necessary, a valid authorization to display advertising on boat;
  - 4.4 The measurement form or certificate of the boat, mast and sail
  - 4.5 A valid third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of  $\in$  1.500.000 per incident, or the equivalent

#### 5. FNTRY FFFS:

The entry fees is € 160,00 and is to be paid by Credit Card by 30 April 2021. Any later entry will be subject to the additional entry fees of € 50,00. From 6 May the registrations can be made only in the secretary office of Univela Sailing.

5.2 The registration shall be displayed at the Entry List only when the Entry Form with all information filled in and the payment of the non-refundable entry fee shall be sent successfully.

The successful payment will be considered a confirmation of entry.

#### 7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available from 7 May 2021 at the race office upon registration.

## 8. RACING FORMAT

- 8.1 A total number of nine (9) races are scheduled.
- 8.2 No more than three races may be sailed per day

#### 9. SCORING

- 9.1 The Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply
- 9.2 The event will be valid even with only one valid race.
- (a) When fewer than six races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When from six to eight races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding the worst score.
- (c) When nine races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

#### 10. MEASUREMENTS

10.1 Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate at registration.

## 11. PRIZES

- 11.1 The following prizes will be awarded:
- Prizes will be awarded to the first 3 classified overall;

#### 12. THE COURSES

12.1 The courses to be sailed will be posted in the Sailing Instruction,

## 13. ADVERTISING

13.1 Boats may be required to display the advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

#### 15. SUPPORT BOATS

15.1 All support boats shall be registered with the Organizing Authority and will be required to comply with local legislation and event support boat regulations.

The Organizing Authority may refuse registrations and accept later registrations at their sole discretion.

15.2 The registrant of a support boat will be charged for a not refundable fee of € 50.

The fee includes crane use (first and last day), trailer parking and berthing in the harbour.

15.3 Support boats with team leaders, coaches and other support personnel shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the starting sequence until all boats have finished or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment. Support boats shall comply with any reasonable request from the regatta officials.

#### 16. RADIO COMMUNICATION

16.1 No equipment capable of radio transmissions or radio communications may be carried by any competitor while on the water. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones and other electronics devices.

## 17. PHOTOGRAPHY CONSENT

17.1 By entering the Championship competitors accept that they may be photographed and/or videotaped participating in the race and/or using the regatta facilities and they consent to the taking of such images and to the use, re-use, publication and republication of such images in any media, in conjunction with the competitor's name or not, without compensation and without the competitor's approval of such images or any use thereof.

#### 18. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 18.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority and its officers, members and volunteers will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 18.2 The establishment of the Notice of Race and the sailing Instruction in no way limits or reduces the complete and unlimited responsibilities of a competitor being solely and entirely responsible for the management of a boat he is sailing.
- 18.3 A competitor shall maintain his boat in a safe and seaworthy condition.
- 18.4 A competitor shall be of good health and a competent sailor capable of racing a A-Class in open water in strong winds and it his sole responsibility to decide to participate in a race or to continue racing.

#### 19. INSURANCE

- 19.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 per incident or the equivalent in currency.
- 19.2 Proof of insurance shall be provided on registration.
- 19.3 Any competitor under the age of 18 years old will be required to obtain parental/guardian









written consent.

## 20. SAFETY AND ENVIRONMENT

#### 20.1 General

By signing the entry fee, competitors shall comply with the following:

- Put safety of yourself and competitors above race results
- Keep the boat park and sailing area clean of any debris

Do not leave the boat park without the necessary safety precaution

- 20.2 A boat that retires from a race shall inform the race committee as soon as possible and before leaving the race area, and shall notify the race office at once on coming ashore.
- 20.3 Boats not leaving the harbour or beach for a day's race shall inform the race office prior to the start.
- 20.4 For vessels equipped with J or Z-boards, the helmsman must wear a safety helmet at all times while racing.









## 21. TRAILER PARKING, DOCKING AND CARS

21.1 All participants shall park their boats and road-trailers on the premises of the harbour Regatta Centre. Cars shall be parked in the designated parking areas. No cars are allowed at the dinghy park. Please follow the beach master's and the harbour master's instructions at all times.



## 22. ACCOMODATION

Competitors shall make their own housing arrangements. The building and the beach area are an unitary complex for accommodation purposes and equipment for leisure and sports services, where all sailors can find:
