1	Rules
1.1	The event is governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) of World Sailing.

3.2	[DP] From the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.
4	Eligibility and Entry
4.1	The event is open to all boats of the standard Youth "C" foil Nacra 15 class
4.2	Eligible boats may enter from 1 March 2022 by completing the entry form online via <u>https://www.campioneunivela.it/en/regattas/2022/nacra-15-world-championship/</u> and submitting it together with the required fee (see NoR 5.1)
4.3	To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirement and pay all fees before:
	* July 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2022 for an Early Entree Fee
	* August 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2022 for a standard Fee (To see NoR Art 5)
4.4	Late entries will be accepted until August 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2022 at 12.00 and a standard entry fee shall be paid (see NoR 5.1)
4.5	All competitors shall comply with World Sailing Eligibility Code 19.
4.6	All crew shall be full members of the International Nacra 15 Class Association: you can register at <a href="https://www.nacra15class.com/membership">https://www.nacra15class.com/membership</a>
4.7	The following shall be produced at the registration on site:

	• A competing team shall be able to right the boat from capsized unassisted and may be asked to demonstrate this afloat prior to racing.
7.	Advertising
7.1	[DP] Boats shall display event advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority conform World Sailing Advertising Code 20.4
7.2	The organizing authority may provide bibs that competitors are required to wear as permitted by the World Sailing Advertising Code.
8	Qualifying series and final series
	The event may consist of a qualifying series and a final series if more than 60 boats are entered.

	(b) When from 5 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores, excluding her worst score
	(c) When 10 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores, excluding her two worst scores.
15.3	Under 19 and Under 16 results will be extracted from overall results without recalculation

16.1	[DP] Support person vessels shall be marked with their National letter.
17	Chartered or loaned boats
17.1	A chartered or loaned boat may carry national letters or a sail number in contravention of her class rules, provided that the race committee has approved her sail identification before the first race. See RRS G3

18.1	[DP] [NP] Boats, trailers, and cars shall be kept in their assigned places.

21	Data Protection, Media Rights, Cameras and Electronic Equipment
21.1	By participating in this event, competitors grant to the Organizing Authority and its sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete and the boat, produced during the period of the competition without compensation.
21.2	[DP] [NP] If required by the Organizing Authority competitors shall give interviews at the regatta.
21.3	[DP] [NP] Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment and positioning equipment as specified and supplied by the Organizing Authority.
21.4	[DP][NP] Competitors shall not interfere with the normal working of the Organizing Authority supplied media equipment.
