1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Organizing Authority is the Italian Sailing Federation (Federazione Italiana Vela), which has delegated the organization to Univela Sailing SSD ARL.

2. RULES

- 1. The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) in force
- 2. The FIV Regulations for Organized National Sport Activities 2025 shall apply as a "rule."
- 3. The Contender Class Rules.
- 4. This NoR, the SI, and all subsequent Official Notices. In case of conflict between NoR and SI, the SI and Official Notices shall prevail (changes RRS 63.7).
- 5. RRS Appendix P (Special Procedures for Rule 42, as modified by the Class Rules) and Appendix T (Arbitration) shall both apply in full

3. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The SI will be available from 12:00 on 4 July 2025 on the event website. They will be published electronically only (no paper copy).

4. NOTICES

- 1. The Official Notice Board will be online on the event website.
- 2. The time of the warning signal for each day's first race will be posted on the ONB by 20:00 on the preceding day. If no notice is posted, the previous day's time remains valid.
- 3. [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data that is not available to all boats
- 4. On racing days, boats shall remain in their assigned area until the display of Flag D. The warning signal or other signal will be made no less than 30 minutes after Flag D is displayed and not before the scheduled or postponed time, whichever is later.

5. ELIGIBILITY

- 1. The event is open to all boats of the Contender Class.
- 2. Italian competitors shall hold a valid FIV membership (including medical certificate) and Class membership for 2025.
- 3. Foreign competitors shall comply with their National Authority's regulations.
- 4. Competitors under 18 must be under the responsibility of a "Support Person," who shall complete the online Parental/Guardian Form, accept RRS 3.1(b), and assume responsibility for their athlete onshore and afloat.







5. Boats shall have third-party liability insurance as required by World Sailing, except Italian athletes holding the FIV Plus card.

6. ENTRY

- 1. Eligible boats shall enter online at the Univela event website above.
- 2. The entry fee of € 70 must be paid by 21 June 2025 at 23:59; late entries incur a € 20 surcharge.
- 3. To be considered entered, a boat must complete registration and payment by credit card via the online form.

7. ADVERTISING

- 1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the OA.
- 2. The OA may provide bibs that competitors shall wear as permitted by World Sailing Advertising Code.

8. SCHEDULE

- **30 June** Contender open day
- 4 July
 - o 16:00–17:00 Registration
- 5 July
 - o 09:00-10:00 Registration
 - o 10:00 Skippers' Meeting
 - 13:00 Warning signal for first race
 - 18:00 Drinks and snacks (in collaboration with Birra Leder)
- 6 July
 - o TBD Races
 - o 17:30 Prize Giving, followed by drinks and snacks (Birra Leder)

Additional Schedule Notes

- Up to 3 races per day, 6 races in total.
- On the last scheduled day, no warning signal will be made after 17:00. Prize giving will follow as soon as possible after racing.
- To indicate that a race or sequence of races will begin soon, the orange starting line flag will be displayed with one sound at least 5 minutes before the warning signal (this is an addition to the Race Signals).







9. MEASUREMENT

[DP] No pre-event measurement checks are scheduled. Competitors shall sail with validly measured boats, equipment, and sails. Measurement checks may be made at any time at the discretion of the TC or RC, afloat or ashore.

10. VENUE

Racing will take place on the waters off Campione del Garda as shown in the SI.

11. COURSES

Courses will be as per Contender Class Rules and described in the SI.

12. SCORING

- 1. The Low Point System of RRS Appendix A will apply.
- 2. One race is required to constitute a series.
- 3. (a) When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When four or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score

13. BERTHING

[DP] Boats shall be kept in their assigned spaces in the boat park.

14. DATA PROTECTION

By entering, competitors and their guardians consent to the processing of their personal data in accordance with Italian Legislative Decree 196/2003 (Arts. 13, 23, 26) and acknowledge they have read the privacy policy.







15. ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY

Participants are encouraged to minimise environmental impact as per RRS 47 – Disposal of Waste: "Competitors and support persons shall not deliberately throw waste into the water...."

16. RISK STATEMENT

RRS 3 states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone." Competitors acknowledge the inherent risk of the sport and confirm they hold valid federation membership with injury insurance (including death and permanent disability). Foreign competitors shall hold equivalent insurance

17. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded as follows:

- 1st, 2nd, 3rd overall
- 1st Under 30
- 1st Over 60

18. MEDIA RIGHTS

By participating, competitors grant the OA full rights to use images and footage for editorial, advertising, and broadcast purposes.
