SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Class: Contender – Campione del Garda, 5–6 July 2025

Organising Authority: Univela Sailing SSD a r.l., under the auspices of the Italian Sailing Federation (FIV)

1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2025–2028.

1.2 The current Contender Class Rules and the Prescriptions of the Italian Sailing Federation (FIV) will apply.

1.3 In case of conflict, the Italian version of these Sailing Instructions will prevail.

2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

3. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted by 08:00 on the day they take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 20:00 on the day before it takes effect.

4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Signals made ashore will be displayed on the official flagpole at the venue.

When flag “AP” is displayed ashore, “1 minute” is replaced with “not less than 30 minutes”.

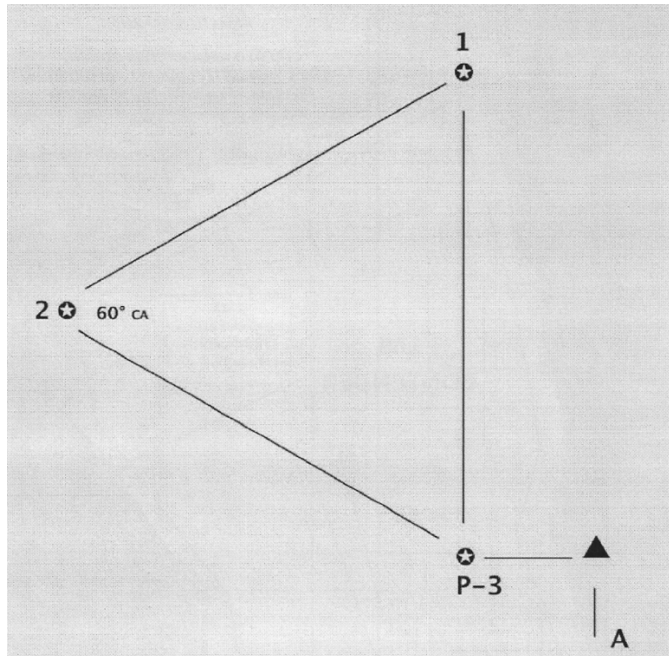
5. SCHEDULE OF RACES

As per the Notice of Race.

6. CLASS FLAG

The class flag will be the letter “C”.

7. COURSE



Course: P-1-2-3-1-3-F

(P = starting mark, numbers refer to rounding marks, F = finish line)

8. MARKS

All marks will be red.

The starting mark will be a red buoy.

The finishing line will be between a red buoy and a staff displaying a blue flag on the Race Committee boat.

9. START

Races will be started according to RRS Rule 26.

The starting line will be between a red buoy and a staff displaying an orange flag on the Race Committee boat.

A boat starting later than 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored DNS without a hearing.

10. CHANGE OF THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE

To change the next leg of the course, the Race Committee may move the mark in accordance with RRS 33.

11. FINISH

The finishing line will be between a red buoy and a staff displaying a blue flag on the Race Committee boat.

12. TIME LIMIT

The time limit for the first boat will be 90 minutes.

Boats failing to finish within 20 minutes after the first boat finishes will be scored DNF without a hearing.

13. PENALTIES

The penalty for a breach of a rule of Part 2 will be a One-Turn Penalty (one tack and one gybe), as per RRS 44.1.

14. PROTESTS

The protest time limit is 60 minutes after the last boat finishes the last race of the day.

A notice of hearings will be posted within 30 minutes after the protest time limit expires.

15. SCORING

The Low Point System of Appendix A of the RRS will apply.

When four or more races have been completed, a boat's worst score will be excluded.

16. SAFETY

A boat that retires from a race shall inform the Race Committee as soon as possible.

17. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (see RRS 3).

The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
